

Crafty Pu'ili Sticks

Actual pu'ili sticks are made from lengths of bamboo, generally around 12 – 18" long. They are left solid at one end and then cut into numerous slats on the other end. Our craft version uses

the cardboard roll from paper towels and adds a few elements for decoration and durability. Supplies you need are:



2 cardboard tubes from paper towels

Scissors

(Optional) Electrical or duct tape

Stickers, markers or other materials for

decoration

This is such an easy craft. Simply cut slits in one side of the cardboard rolls and use the electrical tape or duct tape to wrap the other (uncut) end. This will indicate which side to hold and help the sticks last longer.

Although it's not traditional, you can decorate the cut side, using markers or stickers, paint, glitter and glue or whatever inspires your imagination. Once you're done – it's time to play!
